FACILITIES

The Northern Virginia 4-H Educational Center is located outside Front Royal in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Campers stay in one of four lodges in groups of five with teen and adult supervision. Facilities include an archery range, athletic fields, tennis courts, horse riding rings, an amphitheater, lake, and pool to name a few. The 4-H Center is accredited under the American Camp Association.



STAFF

4-H Camp staff, Extension Agents, and trained volunteer leaders provide camper supervision, instruction, and support. Lifeguards are on duty during all aquatic activities. A camp EMT is on duty 24 hours a day.



WHAT IS 4-H CAMP LIKE?

Morning Activities: Campers choose three classes to attend each day. Sample classes are listed below.

Afternoon Activities: Organized recreation, free swim, and pack meetings.

Evening Activities: Campfires, theme nights, land Olympics, skits, and more!

FUN CLASS CHOICES (Just to name a few)

Archery—An instructor teaches safety and skills with a bow and arrow.



Swimming—From beginners to advanced swimmers, instructors teach swim strokes and water safety.



Outdoor Living Skills—Learn the skills it takes to thrive and survive outdoors and prepare for an overnight, outdoor camping experience (optional)!



Performing Arts—Put your musical, dancing, and acting talents together for a fun class in the dramatics.
